## **2025** Economic Development Legislative Priorities



## Product Development & Site Readiness

- Amend provisions of the Selectsite Readiness Program to allow for a broader use of funds, including on-site preparation and installation/upgrading of public infrastructure to increase speed to market of identified sites at varying stages of site readiness.
- Support increased funding for the Selectsite Readiness Program and allow a subsequent round(s) of statewide applications to increase geographic diversity of sites.
- Amend provisions of the **Megasite Readiness Program** to authorize the use of funds to acquire land, install or upgrade public infrastructure, fund onsite preparation, and expedite environmental needs related to timely Megasite development.

## **Enhancing Competitive Posture**

- Support Western North Carolina recovery and resiliency efforts.
- Seek state appropriations to fund grants for **investments in infrastructure** to create additional capacity for siting new businesses and existing business expansions. This investment will ensure the state remains competitive in a rapidly evolving economy.

## Workforce Innovation

- Support the North Carolina Community College System's goal of reforming Propel NC, realigning program funding by prioritizing programs and courses in highdemand, high-wage fields.
- Encourage state funding to enhance accessible, affordable **childcare**, which will enable parents to remain in the workforce, reduce turnover, and boost productivity, thereby addressing labor shortages and promoting a stable talent pipeline.
- Enhance funding to eliminate the skills gap through **mentorships and apprenticeships** that will provide handson experience, foster career development, and improve job retention.
- Support state appropriations for **completion assistance grants** that will provide financial support for students, facilitate program and credential completion, and result in a higher educated and more skilled workforce.
