Aaron Ouellette is the Manager of Port Centric Logistics for the Virginia Port Authority, overseeing global economic development projects focused on logistics and industrial development. Previously, he worked at the Hampton Roads Chamber. Aaron earned a bachelor's in business marketing from Radford University.



Donna Phillips is the Vice President of Economic Development at NC East Alliance. She connects regional industries to the STEM East Industry In Schools Initiative and supports new industry recruitment across 29 counties. Donna brings extensive experience from roles at Duke Energy, the Economic Development Partnership of North Carolina, and various local agencies. She holds degrees from Chowan University and East Carolina University, including an MBA in Business Administration.



Mark Pope is the President of NC Global TransPark Economic Development Region. Mark is a Lenoir County native and East Carolina University graduate, and has over 20 years of banking experience. He became Lenoir County's economic director in 2005, led the Wayne County Development Alliance in 2018, and has served in his current role since 2020.
